## notice, invite, challenge, empower in the Media

## Objectives:

1. Students will demonstrate their understanding of NICE (notice, invite, challenge, empower) by finding examples that demonstrate NICE in the media (newspaper, magazine, websites, etc.)

#### Materials:

- 1. Journal-Media examples page
- 2. Poster that outlines the different components of NICE
- 3. Current newspapers and magazines as well as internet access (if possible)

### **Motivation:**

Review what each of the different letters mean and why they are so important. Tell the students that NICE exists outside of their classroom and school. Tell the students that the components of NICE are found everywhere. Ask the students if they can think of any examples from the "real world" that demonstrate NICE. Have the students share their examples.

#### Development:

Explain to the students that they are going to be looking for examples of NICE in the media. Tell the students that the media is newspapers, magazines, the internet and anything else that provides information. Each student should find 3 examples. Students will then use the Media examples page of their journal to document what they have found.

#### Closure:

The teacher will ask for a few volunteers to share what they have found.
