INVITE 1st

invite – Journal/Discussion Questions

Objectives:

1. Students will describe a situation where they witnessed inclusion/exclusion (define these words so students know the definition).

Inclusion: the action or state of including or of being included within a group

Exclusion: the process or state of excluding or being excluded.

2. Students will analyze the situation and think of alternative situations.

Common Core Standards:

CCSS.ELA-LITERACY.W.1.1

Write opinion pieces in which they introduce the topic or name the book they are writing about, state an opinion, supply a reason for the opinion, and provide some sense of closure.

Materials:

- 1. Journals/paper to write on
- 2. Writing utensil

Motivation: (3 min)

Explain that today we are going to journal about invite.

Development: (5 min)

Ask students to think about a time when someone was either included or excluded? (it could be themselves or something they witnessed).

What happened?

How did they feel about the situation?

What could have happened differently?



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What could they have done or said differently?

Did you learn anything from the experience?

*Younger students can write/draw a way they can include someone.

Closure: (5 min)

If time, allow student to share their experiences and thoughts with the class or a small discussion group.
